## Loose Leash Walking & Equipment Workshop

Do you walk your dog or does your dog walk you? Are there so many different equipment choices and opinions that you don't know where to start? Struggling with leash control is a very common problem, but it doesn't have to be! This workshop will help you find the right, individualized, most effective equipment and teach you the appropriate techniques to help you better communicate with and control your dog. We will demonstrate and discuss a variety of training tools and help you choose the best option for you and your dog, while being sure the equipment is fit properly and you are well versed in how to use it. Then we will work with you and your dog to help establish good handling, and how to teach your dog how to walk politely. It will soon become a pleasure, not a chore, to walk your dog.

## Greeting Manners Workshop

Does your friendly dog greet people with too much excitement? Does he jump up instead of politely sit when someone approaches him or comes into your home? This workshop will help you solve this common problem by teaching you to encourage your dog to remain seated and calm when he is approached for greeting.

## Mind Your Business

Teach your reactive dog to focus on you! Does your dog lunge, bark, and growl at dogs or people when out in public? Is it impossible to get your dog to listen to you when they are so reactive to other dogs? This workshop will address the basic skills to help your dog control himself when faced with everyday triggers. The most important part of reducing reactivity in your reactive dog is to get him to pay more attention to you, instead of the source of his reactivity. This class will concentrate on your dog's focus on you. As we teach your dog to pay more attention to you, he will look to you for leadership and guidance instead of the dogs setting him off.
